### Program Overview

The Internal Medicine Program is primarily located at Palmetto General Hospital in Hialeah Florida. Each rotation is 4 weeks in length over three years. Throughout the duration of the program, residents will complete one half-day a week of continuity clinic experience thus exposing them to a diverse patient panel. Residents will complete at least 130 half days of continuity clinic throughout their training and be immersed in several subspecialties of Internal Medicine.

### Selective

For rotations listed as "Selective" in the block schedule, residents will select from a list of IM subspecialties to be assigned on the inpatient setting. These "Selective" options include: Pulmonology, Radiology, Gastroenterology, and Cardiology.

### Outpatient Selective

For Rotations listed as "Outpatient Selective" on the block schedule, residents will select from a list of IM subspecialties to be assigned on the outpatient setting. These "Outpatient Selective" options include: Dermatology, Rheumatology, and Nephrology.

### Elective

For rotations listed as "Elective" on the block schedule, residents may select from a list of clinical experiences on either the inpatient or outpatient setting. Elective options include: ICU, Nephrology, Neurology, Rheumatology, Infectious Disease, Gastroenterology, Cardiology, Hematology/Oncology, Otolaryngology, Ophthalmology, Dermatology, Non-operative Orthopedics, Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation/Sports Medicine.
